COUNTY CHAMPS! The Boys **Cross Country** team won the Marion County Championship last Saturday to cap off their season. At the race, we had 4 boys place in the top 25 and earn medals. They were Dominic Daggy (12th) Tristen Trevino (10th) CJ Priddle (8th) and Bennett DuBois (1st). DuBois completed an undefeated season at the race and set a new school record time in the process. The Girls team finished 8th at the race and featured 2 medalists: Lu-Si Minnich (16th) and Esperanza Lopez (21st).

Our **Football** teams travelled to Lawrence North last night to take on Fall Creek Valley. The 7th grade posted a 50-0 victory over the Bearcats limiting them to just one first down all game and ended their season 6-2. The 8th Grade won 24-14 and finished their season 7-1.

Girls **Soccer** won both games this week and finished the season 12-2-2 which was good for the most wins in school history. The ladies finished in 2nd place in the final conference standings. The Boys team split their games this week defeating Pendleton Heights before falling to FCV. They finished the season 7-6-3.

Tennis concluded its season Wednesday night at Lawrence Central vs Fall Creek Valley losing two close matches. The boys team finished the season 4th in the MIIC, while the girls placed 6th.
